

## GOATS



A milking goat can provide milk and can be a source of income. With a relatively modest investment of money in goats, Maasai women can be empowered in their own families and villages: they can feed their families and earn money. The IMAGE Project partners with the Maasai women around the village of Kwale, outside of Iringa, on goat projects.

The IMAGE Project consults with the women who receive goats from the organization to monitor successes and challenges with the projects, and strives to work with the women to address any challenges.

During our 2008 visit to the village of Kwale, we invited a local veterinarian to put on a goat seminar for the women. The veterinarian demonstrated how to trim hooves, do appropriate worming, and gave other helpful instruction. The women now have more than 40 goats, which they own collectively, and are very excited to be running their own project successfully.

Each goat costs \$30.
